SBAI Outcomes – The Alternative Investment Standards



We set clear standards and actively promote responsible practice to normalise quality and fairness

Areas Addressed Investors need to be adequately informed about investment policy, commercial terms, and performance • Disclosure Disclosure to lenders, prime brokers: counterparties need to be informed to make sound credit decisions Conflicts of interest need to be adequately mitigated by segregating portfolio management and valuation ٠ Valuation functions Clear rules for valuing illiquid or other difficult to value assets are required Risk Asset managers need to put in place a risk management framework to adequately deal with risk taking in areas such as portfolio risk, operational risk, outsourcing risk, and liquidity Management Fund Adequate governance mechanisms and oversight are required to mitigate conflicts of interest inherent to a funds organisational and governance structure Governance Shareholder All fund managers have to comply with applicable law and regulation; best practices include measures to prevent market abuse and restriction on voting on borrowed stock Conduct
