The Standards Board for Alternative Investments (SBAI) is a neutral standard-setting body for the alternative investment industry and custodian of the Alternative Investment Standards (the Standards), providing a framework of transparency, integrity and good governance for alternative investment managers.

SBAI Objectives:

- Foster and promote good industry conduct
- Facilitate investor due diligence
- Provide benchmark for manager practice
- Complement public policy objectives, such as facilitating fair and efficient markets, investor protection, and reducing systemic risk

Our stakeholders:

- **Alternative Asset Manager accounting for > USD 2 trillion in AUM are signed up to the Standards** (Hedge Funds, CTAs, Alternative Credit, and ILS managers)
- **Institutional Investors representing > USD 5 trillion in assets have joined the SBAI Investor Chapter and support the adoption of the Standards** (Pensions, Sovereign Wealth Funds, Endowments, Foundations and others)

The SBAI facilitates collaboration between managers, investors and regulators to share common concerns and develop practical, industry-wide solutions through its working groups, initiatives, and events.
